The owner was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.

Mr. Dria testified that the owner of the animal failed to comply with vaccination reporting requirements for an animal involved in a bite. Mr. Dria requested that the animal owner be declared as having failed to provide rabies prevention verification and to be authorized to file criminal charges to achieve compliance with the revised code.

There being no further testimony, the hearing ended at 11:35 AM.

Mr. Dria requested that the animal owner be declared as having failed to provide rabies prevention verification and to be authorized to file criminal charges to achieve compliance with the revised code.

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The hearing for the property at 504 Belden Ave SE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:44 AM.


The property owner, Gary Haley, was not present. Gus Dria was sworn in to testify.
