The hearing for the property at 1027 16th St NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:37 AM.


Property owner, Steve Filliez, was not present. Mark Adams was sworn in to testify.

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The hearing for the property at 1327 Shriver NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:38 AM.


Property owner, Paul Galati, was not present. Mark Adams was sworn in to testify.

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The hearing for the property at 1231 Lawrence Rd NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:38 AM.



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The hearing for the property at 1823 3rd St NE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:39 AM.


Property owner, Asharae Travis, was not present. Mark Adams was sworn in to testify.

The hearing for the property at 1319 13th St SE, Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:40 AM.


Property owner, Sophia Quincy, was not present. Mark Adams was sworn in to testify.

The hearing for Rocsiz Chicken and Waffles #537 in Canton, Ohio was called to order by Dr. Stephen Hickman at 11:41 AM.


A representative of the business was not present. Mark Adams was sworn in to testify.
