Dr. Amy Hite is the Administrative Director and Clinical Manager for the Darleen C. Claypoole, R.N. CARE Center (Center for AIDS Research and Education) Department of Medicine, Summa Health System in Akron, Ohio. The CARE Center is located on the Summa Akron City Hospital Campus. Summa's HIV specialty CARE Center is dedicated to providing state of the art consultation and treatment services to patients with HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus). Dr. Hite directs and oversees care of greater than 600 CARE Center patients. She is an attending physician of General Medicine and HIV Teaching Services, both inpatient and outpatient. She is advisor of the Internal Medicine Residency Program and is Assistant Professor of Internal Medicine, Northeastern Ohio Medical University. In addition, she is Medical Director of Equitas Health in Akron.
