All patients 18 years of age and older must bring a photo ID and insurance card(s) on the day of their appointment.

Acceptable payment methods include cash, check, Debit card, American Express, Apple Pay, Discover, Google Pay, MasterCard, Samsung Pay and VISA. There will be a flat fee of \$2.00 for Debit cards and \$2.00 or 3% of the total amount of the charge (whichever is higher) for credit cards and contactless payments.

Canton City Public Health is in network and will submit claims to the following insurance companies for travel clinic services: Amerihealth Caritas, Anthem, Anthem Medicaid, Aultcare, Buckeye, CareSource, Cigna, Humana, Humana Healthy Horizons, Medicaid, Medical Mutual, Molina, Paramount, PrimeTime, United Healthcare and United Healthcare Community Plan. Individuals are responsible for co-pays, deductibles and/or non-covered services.

Patients with insurance companies not listed above are required to self-pay on day of service and can request an itemized receipt to submit to his/her insurance company.
