Canton City Public Health Providing Adult COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic at Former Nationwide Building

(Canton, OH) - Canton City Public Health (CCPH) is providing weekly COVID-19 vaccination clinics for adults age 18 years or older on Wednesdays at the former Nationwide Building, 1000 Market Ave. N., from 11:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.

This clinic is for those who are:

- age 18 or older getting a 1st, 2nd or 3rd dose.
- age 18 or older getting their first booster.
- age 50 or older getting their 2nd booster (must be at least 4 months since receiving the first booster).
- age 18 or older who are immunocompromised getting their 2nd booster (must be at least 4 months since receiving the first booster.)

Moderna (Spikevax) and Johnson & Johnson (J&J) vaccine are offered at the adult clinic.

As always, COVID-19 vaccinations are free. Clients are asked to bring their photo I.D. and COVID-19 vaccination card if they have one.
