Mosquito Spraying to Take Place

(Canton, OH) – Canton City Public Health (CCPH) announced today that mosquito spraying will take place beginning Friday, June 21 through Tuesday, July 2, 2024.

CCPH vector control staff conduct various practices to reduce mosquitoes in our neighborhoods. In addition to spraying, vector control staff identify and remove areas of stagnant water, and larvicide, which is the primary method of mosquito abatement. Larviciding kills mosquitoes at the larval stage while spraying targets adult mosquitoes.

To reduce mosquitoes and mosquito bites, city residents should remove items from yards that can collect and hold water such as old tires, cans, buckets and bottles, and protect themselves by limiting time outdoors during peak mosquito activity (dusk to dawn) and using an approved insect repellant when outdoors.
