Dear Food Establishments,

I hope you are all doing well. We have seen a huge change in our day to day activities due to COVID-19. At this time the Ohio Governor Mike Dewine has issued the Director's Dine Safe Ohio Order that can be found on our website at cantonhealth.org and also on coronavirus.ohio.gov. This order allows Restaurants and Bars to reopen so long as all workplace safety standards are met. What this means for our restaurants here in Canton City is that we please ask you to complete all the requirements stated below.

A written plan on:

- Description on how barriers will be used (if used)
- Description of increased cleaning and disinfecting
- Mask use
- Description on waiting areas (if used)
- Description of employee sick time use

A drawing or a photo of new table/seating set up

- Tables/seating must be 6ft apart
- All entrances and exists

In this envelope you will find a few posters we ask that you use within your facility and also a COVID-19 Employee Reporting form that every employee will have to sign and a COVID-19 Employee Health Log that employees must fill out daily before their scheduled work shift. We ask that you keep these documents on file for review during inspections.
